

Forklift Electrician

Your job will be responsible for the fabrication, installation and troubleshooting of engine wiring harnesses, wiring for lights and electrical components on an industry leading truck mounted forklift. Job duties include wiring electrical circuits, using hand and power tools, reading and understanding schematics, and testing completed work with live voltage. As an assembly technician, your responsibilities include assembly of the product, often with a team.

Prospective candidates should be able to use various tools, equipment and machines. They should possess manual dexterity and be able to keep records, do detailed work and perform repetitive tasks. Other important qualities are resourcefulness, good memory, and an interest in ideas and information.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Safely use and operate various tools including power tools, hoists, and production equipment.
- Must have basic electrician tools.
- Automotive electrical experience is required.
- Ability to read wiring schematics required and ability to build wiring harnesses.
- Maintain a consistent pace throughout the shift with focus on quality (i.e., within applicable quality standards).
- Maintain regular, reliable attendance and reliable transportation.
- Ability to read, understand, and follow established processes and instructions.
- Follow all safety rules and regulations strictly and maintain a clean and orderly work area.
- Participate in continuous improvement process.
- Perform duties assigned by Supervisor and/or Group Leader.
- Ability to work alone or as a team.
- State/government issued ID and Social Security card are a must.

Work overtime as required and mandated by production

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to lift up to 40 lbs. and push/pull up to 100 lbs.
- Ability to bend, twist, turn, kneel, and squat.
- Stand and walk up to eight hours per day and reach overhead continuously.
- Use air/power/vibrating tools and do strong, pincher gripping.
- Work safely around moving equipment, power tools, and industrial vehicles.
- Repetitive use of upper extremities.
